

Down The Garden Path

Come have a fun day starting this combination project with quick piecing and mock hand appliqué on the machine. The strong diagonal lines created in the design make this very pleasing as a wall quilt or a bed quilt. Yardage is provided for both sizes. Your sewing machine must have a zig-zag stitch with adjustable width and length. You will have at least one pieced block completed and one appliqué block well under way.

Pattern and supply fee: \$11.00

Supplies:

Sewing machine –BRING YOUR BEST SEWING MACHINE

Sewing machine needles for piecing, 80/12 and 60/8 microtex or machine appliqué (60/8 can be hard to find, I will have some to purchase in class)

Open embroidery foot for your machine

Zipper foot, or a top or edge stitching foot for your machine. If you are not sure about these bring all of your feet. One of them usually does the job.

Thread for piecing

Thread for machine appliqué-Sew Art or YLI .004 recommended

Fabric markers, to mark on the back of the fabric

Irons and pressing boards

Cutting board, rotary cutter, and ruler to use with rotary cutter

Paper scissors and fabric scissors

Silk pins or other fine pins

Water soluble glue stick

Fabrics: 100% cotton prewashed and ironed

Wall Quilt:

Dark print-1/2 yard

Dark print for border-1 3/4 yards

Flower print-1/2 yard

Light print-1 1/4 yards

Light print for border-1 3/4 yards

Green-3/4 yard

For center of flower-1/8 yard

Binding-3/8 yard

Double Bed Quilt:

Dark print-1 yard

Dark print for border- 2 1/2 yds

Flower print-1 yard

Light print-2 1/2 yards

Lt. print for border-2 1/4 yards

Green-1 3/4 yards

For center of flower-1/4 yard

Binding-1 yard
