

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Come make this wall hanging with a house in the middle, appliquéd wreath inner border and a log cabin outer border. Wait until you see this cute project and you'll want to make several. You will learn paper piecing, quick piecing, appliqué and mitering.

PATTERN PLUS FEE: \$11.00

FABRIC-100% cotton prewashed and ironed

3/8 yard for roof, heart, center squares of log cabin blocks and binding

1/8 yard for sky (or scraps)

1/4 yard green for leaves (or scraps)

1/4 yard for stem

1/8 yard first light

1/2 yard second light

1/2 yard third light

1/4 yard first dark

3/8 yard second dark

3/4 yard third dark

Cut the following strips prior to class

Cut all strips 1 1/4" wide and 45" long, unless otherwise noted.

Cut 1 strip of center fabric (trim to 27" long)

Cut 2 strips of first light (trim 1 strip to 27" long)

Cut 3 strips of first dark

Cut 4 strips of second light

Cut 4 strips of second dark

Cut 5 strips of third light

Cut 5 strips of third dark

Bring all excess fabric to class.

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

Cutting board, rotary cutter and ruler

Sewing machine - BRING YOUR BEST MACHINE

Extra sewing machine needles

Zipper or top or edge stitching foot

Water soluble glue stick

Thread for piecing

Paper and fabric scissors

Pencil

Freezer paper 7" x 7"

Iron and board

Press cloth-old hand towel or wash cloth will work great
