

# MODERN DAHLIA

## SUPPLY LIST

This little wall quilt is fun and easy to make. While you hand appliqué you will learn to make nice smooth curves, sharp points and perfect circles. You will also learn to make smooth, even stems.

The finished size is 22 1/2" x 22 1/2"

Includes the following: Templar, Brush, full sized pattern, transfer papers, glue pen and more.

#### SUPPLY LIST

- Pencil
- Fine thin pins
- Scissors- both paper and fabric
- Fabric markers to trace around templates on back of fabric
- Sandpaper or sandpaper board-optional
- Rotary cutter board and ruler...smaller size
- Tape-any kind will do, painters tape or repositionable tape recommended
- Strong thread for a small amount of hand sewing....light color....could be hand quilting thread or 100% polyester...something that will not break easily.
- Needle with an eye large enough for your thicker thread.
- 1/4" Clover bias maker
- Emery board
- Iron and ironing board

#### FABRICS:

Background- 12" x 12" (area behind Dahlia flower)

Two green pieces- 5 1/2" x 3" (leaves)

Twenty-one pink pieces- 2" x 4" (petals)

5" x 5" of green for stem

Large circle- 2" x 2"

Small circle- 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

Three pieces for the large outside fabrics: one piece cut 13" x 24" and two pieces cut 13" x 13".

Four pink strips cut 1" x 12"

(Twenty-one pink pieces.....bring a variety or bring some extras and swap with other students in class for more variety.)

I will be providing each student with one of my favorite appliqué needles and the use of my favorite appliqué threads.

I will have the 1/4" Clover bias makes available for purchase in class at a reduced price.
